

## Parents/Carers

We work closely with parents and Carers to help them support their children to make informed careers choices. Parents and Carers are encouraged to attend careers events and information evenings. We actively encourage parental feedback and will use this to evaluate our careers program.

### BY THE END OF KEY STAGE 4, STUDENTS WILL HAVE:

- Accessed and used labour market information to inform their own decisions on study options.
- Experienced subject lessons where teachers highlight the relevance of their subjects for a wide range of future careers.
- Had opportunities to learn from employers (Work Experience, Employer Talks, etc.)
- Attended an options evening to discuss post-16 choices with colleges, Ask Apprenticeship services and other post 16 providers, and also with our impartial professional careers adviser.
- Accessed a 1:1 guidance interview with our impartial professional careers adviser, receiving support to help them firm up their choices post-16.
- Chosen and applied for an appropriate pathway post-16.
- Attended a careers fair to meet with a range of employers, apprenticeship providers, colleges and universities to help inform their decisions

By the time learners are ready to leave they will be even more able to make their own career plan;

- Start to feel better about managing their transitions, using coping strategies.
- Know how to look for opportunities and who to ask for assistance if support is required.
- Be able to complete application forms and update CV's
